- Piaget's constructivism
 Children are active learners
 Children construct knowledge from their surrounding
- Vigotsky's social constructivism
 Children are influenced by their social environment, cultural context, and interaction with peers, parents and teachers

IMPORTANT ASPECTS IN LESSON PLANNING

- Objectives
- Context
- Sequence
- Evaluation

- Learn what you need for the next step
 Learning the languagee skill needed for thenext activity
- Moves from receptive to productive
 Starting from listening or reading focusing on understanding/meaning to speaking and/or writing

- Moves from more controlled/more supported to freer and less supported
 - First activity is more structured, and next is more independent
- From easy to more difficult/challenging
 Starting from easier aspect of linguistic and cognitive, to more difficult or chillenging

- Impersonal > personal
 starting from things related to impersonality to expressing their personal experience
- Concrete to more abstract
 Introducing real objects first, then imaginative ones

Activity dependency
 One activity depends on another activity
